Sybase® WorkSpace 1.5 combines enterprise modeling, database and mobile development, service assembly and orchestration, and web application development into a seamless environment.

Through the enhancement of the existing features and the addition of new features, such as Web Application Development, Sybase WorkSpace provides a fully integrated design and development platform.

General Features

Eclipse 3.1.2 Supports the latest version of the Eclipse framework.

Dynamic online help Provides context-sensitive, embedded help. You simply use the Help

menu item to dynamically display the help you need to guide you through

the task at hand.

Generic JMS Supplies a Generic JMS driver definition that enables the use of external

JMS providers and user-defined connections.

Multiple database access Provides a single database connection profile that supports multiple

databases within a server.

Tutorials and Samples

Provides two types of tutorials and samples: end-to-end and component-based. End-to-end SybStore tutorials and samples span the complete feature set of Sybase WorkSpace. Component tutorials and samples guide you through using the Web Application Development feature and Adaptive Server Enterprise. Database Development

This component streamlines the database development process with the following new capabilities and features:

Adaptive Server® Enterprise 15.0

Provides tooling for Adaptive Server Enterprise (ASE) 15.0 to handle medium to large data stores. With ASE 15.0, you can use new data types and SQL grammar in procedural objects and display graphical query plans.

Additionally, Database Development has enhanced support for ASE 15.0 features.

The SybStore end-to-end tutorials for Database Development are updated to include lessons on the new ASE 15.0 features. And the component tutorials highlight features for developing and debugging triggers and stored procedures in ASE 15.0.

Database creation

Allows you to create simple Adaptive Server Enterprise, Adaptive Server Anywhere, or Sybase IQ databases for use in Sybase WorkSpace application development.

Database server administration

Provides an external tool command in the GUI to start database servers.

Developer productivity enhancements

- SQL Results View Adds new display options, including text/grid and single/multiple displays, user-defined delimiters, and an execution history filter.
- Referenced Tables View and Table Data Editor Enables the viewing and editing of tables while debugging.
- *Temporary Tables* Enables creation of the ASE nonsharable temporary tables referenced in procedural objects.
- Connection-Level Options Enables the changing of database option values for launching procedural objects.

• *Tabbing support in creation wizards*— Facilitates navigating table cells with the TAB key while creating new resources.

Real-time Messaging Services

Provides support for Real Time Messaging Services (RTMS) and XML functions, enabling conversion between SQL results or statements and XML documents that can be used in messages.

You can capture transactions in an Adaptive Server Enterprise database and deliver them as messages to external applications through a Java Message Service message bus.

Replication Server 12.6 and 15.0

Supports the latest version of the Sybase Replication Server®. Enables data replication and maintenance across multiple Adaptive Server Enterprise databases while ensuring integrity and consistency. You can create and manage replication definitions for databases, tables, and functions, and manage database subscriptions for the data replicated from primary databases.

Web Application Development

This powerful new component utilizes the JavaServerTM Faces (JSF) framework to enable the development, testing, debugging, and deployment of a Web application on a runtime server.

The component supports the building of JavaServer Pages (JSP) for JSF and HTML applications, enabling both visual and code-oriented development. Additionally, it provides an integrated environment for incorporating DataWindow® technology and building Web applications that interface with public SOAP service invocations.

The SybStore end-to-end tutorials are updated to include lessons on the Web Application Development features. And the component tutorials highlight features for developing web applications.

Automatic code generation

Available for artifacts that invoke public SOAP services in a Web page and for JavaServer Page layouts that are based on managed beans.

Data Binding view

Enables value and method binding to user interface components.

JSF Application Configuration editor Enables creating and editing of JavaServer Faces (JSF) application configuration files.

It provides the following additional features:

• Graphical editor to facilitate the linking of Web pages.

- Form-based editor to easily define and edit the parameters of the *faces-config.xml* file.
- Source editor to view the code base of the *faces-config.xml* file.

Multi-tab properties view

Enables defining and editing Web page control properties and attributes.

Object creation wizards

Provide a complete set of wizards to facilitate the creation of Web pages and their components.

Resource Bundle editor

Enables resource bundle message file creation and editing.

Reuse of DataWindow libraries

Enable importing of existing DataWindow libraries into Sybase WorkSpace.

Testing and debugging tools

Enable Web page validation throughout the development life-cycle.

Troubleshooting tools

Assist in troubleshooting design and development problems. These include:

- Problems view to identify if the Java source code in a JSP page has compilation errors.
- Error markers on the Source page to identify the cause and solution for an
 error. A simple mouse-over the error marker displays the problem cause,
 and double-clicking the error marker displays possible resolutions.
- Error logs to identify design time errors.

Web application development

Supports Web application development based on:

- DataWindows
- EJB managed beans
- Java managed beans
- Service managed beans

Web page editor

Supports both graphical and code-based design and editing with a design canvas in the upper half of the editor and a source view in the lower half.

The Web Page editor allows you to:

- Maximize the design canvas pane nd source pane using the resize icons on the main tool bar.
- Enter and edit text directly on the design canvas.
- Resize JSF HTML controls on the design canvas.
- Manipulate all objects on the design canvas.

- Undo and redo all commands entered in the Web Page editor using the Edit menu in the main menu bar.
- Add CSS styles to any object by a simple right-click on the object.
- Drag and drop controls from a Palette directly onto the Web Page editor.
- Drag and drop properties and methods from the Data Bindings view onto the Web Page editor to automatically generate a JSP layout and bind business logic to controls.

XML editor

Enables web.xml file creation and editing for web page development.
